

NOW THIS TRUST DEED WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS :

(1) In order to effectuate the said object and establishing a public charitable Trust, the settlor has delivered and hand over to the Trustees a sum of Rs.1,000/- (Rs. One Thousand only) with intent to part with all his rights, title and interest claim therein and vest the same in the Trustees to have and to hold the same and the investment or investments for the time being representing the same and all other properties that may for the time being represent the Trust estate together with all additions and acceptations thereto and all accumulated income thereof and all other property or properties that may be acquired out of the same or otherwise may hereafter be subject to the Trust (hereinafter referred to the 'The Trust Fund') for the charitable objects and purposes and uses hereinafter expressed with the powers and on the terms and conditions herein contained of the concerning the same.

(2) Name of the Trust shall be 'MATA CHHANNO DEVI SEWA TRUST'.

(3) OFFICE of the Trust shall be situated at B-6/6, Sector-3, Rohini, Delhi-110085, which may be changed from time to time to such other place or places as the Trustee may deem fit and proper at their discretion.

(4) Trust could have its unit officers at any place in India and Abroad.

(5) The objects of the Trust shall be :

i. To start establish, run, manage and control various Anath Ashram, Old Aged Home, Children Home all over in India as and when the Board of Trustee may decide from time to time.

ii. To organise various kinds of child welfare programs/activities.

iii. To start, establish, run take over or manage and maintain schools, with an object to provide sound pre-primary, secondary, senior secondary and higher education to children by seeking recognition and affiliation from the education departments and concerned Govt. Authorities.

iv. to organise meetings, seminars, discussions and press conferences to raise legal demands and fundamental rights provided by the 'Constitution of India',

v. To open, found, establish, promote, set up, run, maintain and manage p.c., Dharamshala, Night/Day Shelters, Old Aged Homes, Orphanages, Health Care Centers, Charitable Dispensaries, Hospitals, Libraries, Reading Rooms, Play Grounds, Stadiums (both open and indoor), Yoga Training Centre, Sangeetalay, & Nrityalay, (music and dance training centers) and other buildings/institutions.

vi. To rehabilitate destitute women like you and old widows, unmarried mothers, victims of abduction and their dependents children through residential care and vocational training.

vii. To give, provide and/or render monetary and/or other help and assistance for the relief of persons and animals affected by natural and other calamities such as flood, fire, famine, cyclone, earthquake, storm, accident, pestilence, drought, epidemic, unbearable cost of living and the like, to give donations, subscriptions or contributions to institutions, establishment, centers or persons doing relief work on such occasion.

viii. To provide food, cloths, shelter, medicines and other required facilities to the people who have faced Natural Calamity and/or disaster.

ix. To help poor and indigent persons in marriages of their sons and daughter by way of donation or otherwise and to distribute clothes, food and other necessities of daily life amongst the poor, orphan and indigent persons.

x. To offer prizes and grant scholarship to deserving students and also provide all possible facilities to the students who are interested to go abroad for higher education.

xi. To provide information and education/useful knowledge and the medical advise, to general public regarding the vices of the trust like Smack, Smoking (Cigarette/Biri/Hukka), and also organize the lectures by expert team of Doctors, journalists, Lawyers, professionals and other learned persons.

xii. To open centers/institutes for diagnostics curative and research of cancer, AIDS, T.B., and other deadly diseases.

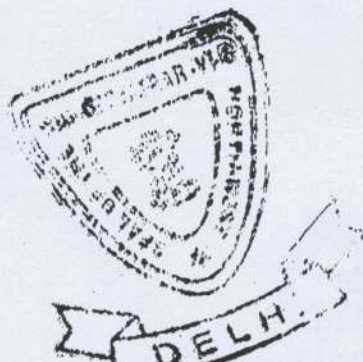
xiii. To arrange and organise EYE and Blood Donations camps all over in India and also in the other countries of the world.

xiv. To invest the Trust funds in the various Financial Gain projects/schemes for the purpose of raising funds of the Trust or spend the same for the fulfillment of objects of the Trust.

xy. To approach to the competent court/courts to safeguards the right of the general public and for the public interests from time to time as the Trust may deem fit and proper.

xvi. To receive financial and non-financial assistance from Govt. Non Govt. Organisation, International Agencies, Banks and any other legal entity or individual.

xvii. to accept donation, grants, presents, gifts and other offerings in the shape of movable/immovable properties for the attainment of the aims and objects of the Trust.

xviii. To purchase/acquire the land/or the land and/or the building in the name of Trust for upliftment and fulfillment of the Aims and objects of the Trust.

xix. To hold and management the assests and properties acquired/inherited or purchased by the Trust as may be necessary or appropriate for the achievement of the objectives of the Trust.

xx. To run establish, manage technical institution, higher education institution, medical college, dental college, nursing college, defence academy, naturopathy centre, conil , pilot licenceing. engg.

xxi. To assist and co-operate the other association, Trust, and the various N.G.Os. whose aims are same like the trust.

xxii. To do such other things/acts/activities which are necessary and which may be incidental or conducive to that attainment of any of the object of the Trust. To construct, run, manage, and operate infrastructure, which may be essential to run higher technical institution e.g. aerodrone and deboratories.

xxiii. To run, manage, establish research & development institute, educational institute in the field of bio-technology, medical technology, information & technology, information & technology, nursery teacher training institute, technical educational institute. •

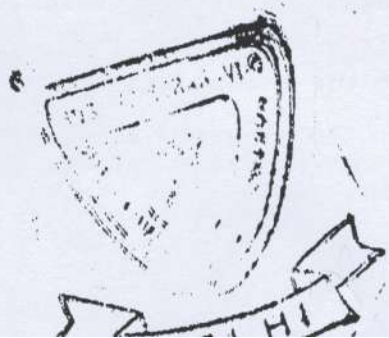
xxiv. To conduct the special programs in the research & development of cancer dieses.

xxv. Trust will invest its money and funds according to sec-11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

xxvi. To acquire, afflication and training facility with any foreign university, college or university for higher technical education.

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8. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Settler and Trustees shall constitute the Board of Trustees. The Trustees and Founder will elect out of themselves one person as a chairman and other person as secretary of the Board of Trustees for three years and under his chairmanship the meeting of the Board of Trustees shall conduct its proceedings.

The Board of Trustees shall appoint all types of employee i.e. Manager, supervisors, legal adviser and legal assistant, accountant, cashier, peon, chowkidar or any other staff required to fulfill the objects of the trust. They have also powers to terminate the services of any staff as they may deem fit and proper for the benefit of the Trust.

(7) During the life time of Founder/Trustees, they can appoint their nominee and after their the appointed nominee and in case none is appointed then the legal heir will enjoy all the rights of Founder/Trustees and presently the Founder /Trustees are enjoying. This process of nomination of successor shall continue till the working of the Trust. to repeat the settler/Trustees or the nominees(s) shall continue to hold all those powers at present enjoyed by the Settler/Trustees.

(8) The Board of Trustees will be the absolute incharge of the Trust and will exercise all the Discretionary and sovereign powers.

(9) It is hereby declared that no part of trust property or its income shall be applied for any purpose other than the objects of the Trust as understood under the Income Tax Act, for the time being in force, and the surplus funds if any of the Trust shall be invested as per the provisions of Income Tax Act.

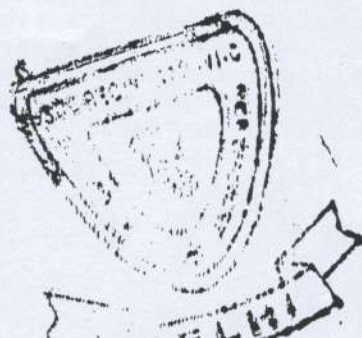
(10) Number of the Trustees shall not be less than two and not more than eleven. Trustees shall not be trustees for their life time but any Trustees may resign by giving in writing to the Co-trustee. Appointment of Trustee(s) shall be only with the final approval of Board of Trustees.

(11) The general management and control of the Trust properties and its affair shall be vested in the Trustees and the Trustees shall have power to do the all such acts as may be considered necessary for the benefits of the Trust and/or management of its properties and affairs.

(12) Without prejudice to any of the powers that the trustees may have under any law for the time being in force or to their general power for management the trustees shall have the following powers :



- a) To manage the Trust, the Trust fund, Trust property and other affairs relating to the Trust and to do all acts, deeds and things necessary for the preservation, maintenance and management thereof and the affairs relating thereto or connected therewith, including the making of Rules and Regulation from time to time.
- b) To apply and part of the Trust funds in acquiring movable and/or immovable properties and sell, mortgage, alienate or otherwise dispose off the same as they may think fit and proper in the interest of trust.
- c) To take on rent or lease, purchase or construct building and to construct, add, alter, demolish, maintain sell, dispose off, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund, for the achievement of objects of the Trust.
- d) To acquire purchase, vary, sell convert, change, transfer, transpose or otherwise deal with all or any of the investment including shares, Stock, debentures, Govt. Securities belonging to the trust or representing the Trust Funds and to re-invest the same as the Trustees may deem fit and proper in accordance with the provisions of Income Tax Act.
- e) To let out, demise any property comprised in the Trust fund for such period and at such rent discretion may think fit.
- f) To apply and get registered under any law of Act of Govt. of India or any State of India.
- g) To accept donation, contribution, gifts and/or other grant-in-aid either in money or in kind.
- h) To enter into any contract and borrow money for the purposes of the Trust and management of its properties and assets.
- i) To open account(s) and give directions to transfer, endorse and sign government securities. Promissory notes, shares, debentures, securities, instruments etc. and all these accounts shall be operated by the Trustees jointly and/or severally as decided by them but the decision of the Founder/Nominee(s) of the successor(s) shall be final.
- j) To appoint sub Committees comprising one Trustee or more for carrying out the objects and purpose of Trust and/or matter connected with the Trust and/or its affairs.
- k) To institute suits, actions, and legal proceedings, to prefer appeals, to make applications or petitions, and to give affidavits, wherever necessary and to defend or compound, compromise, abandon, submit to arbitration or otherwise settle any suit, action claim, legal proceedings appeals, demands or dispute relating to Trust.



(16) The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to sue in the name of Trust and may similarly be sued in the name of Trust.
